

HOUSE GUIDELINES FOR ON-PREMISE BEER

- Never serve an intoxicated person any alcohol - Don't over serve alcohol
- Understand what intoxication is and the visible signs of intoxication
- Never allow an intoxicated person to drive a vehicle
- Beer sold shall be in a size of container that does not exceed two liters, except that beer may not be sold to an individual patron in a size of container that exceeds one liter
- I. D. - customers under 21 years of age can not drink or purchase alcohol or be on the premise of a tavern
- Record and report all alcohol related incidents
- All employees should cooperate with each other and with management
- Obey all state and local laws concerning alcohol
- Always wear a proper name badge
- Never consume or be under the influence of alcohol while on duty
- Be a professional in the service of alcohol and other responsibilities
