

GUIDELINES FOR PRIVATE CLUBS WITH LIQUOR LICENSES

- Never serve an intoxicated person alcohol - Don't over serve alcohol
- Never allow an intoxicated person to drive a vehicle
- Check membership to see if patron is a current member
- I. D. - customers under 21 years of age can not enter certain private clubs and under 21 years old can never purchase or consume alcohol
- Record and report all alcohol related incidents
- All employees should cooperate with each other and with management
- Obey all state and local laws concerning alcohol
- Always wear a proper name badge
- An employee of a club, while on duty, may not: consume an alcoholic beverage; be intoxicated; or act as a host for a guest.
- Be a professional in the service of alcohol and other responsibilities
- Understand how much alcohol can be in a single drink
- Understand how many drinks can be in front of a customer at one time and the total amount of alcohol in front of customer at one time.
